A. Purpose

The purpose of this "Request for Proposal" (RFP) is to solicit professional engineering firms (hereinafter called "Consultants") for detailed proposals to perform the engineering design for the above-mentioned roads. Thomas County Public Works will review the Proposals and make a recommendation to the Thomas County Board of Commissioners (Owner), based upon an evaluation of the following criteria: recent detailed project experience, personnel assigned to project (Project Team), schedule for completion, and lump sum price for engineering services.

B. Issuing Office

This RFP was prepared for the Thomas County Board of Commissioners by the Thomas County Public Works Department. This Project's representative with concern to this RFP is Tony Bodiford with Thomas County Public Works.

C. Scope of Service

The primary scope of services is to complete a topographic survey and design of Williamsburg Ave. (.27 miles), Liberty Street (.59 Miles), Constitution Ave. (.10 Miles), Constitution Ave. Extension (.12 Miles), and Independence Drive (.05 Miles) and produce a set of plans to be bid out for construction.

The scope of work is to be completed by the Consultant will generally include the following:

- Thomas County Board of Commissioners has intentions to use 2024 Supplemental LMIG funds to fund this project.
 - Thomas County Public Works will have to acquire Right-of-Way for round-a-bout.
 - Thomas County will provide a conceptual drawing that has been approved by the Thomas County Commission Board.
 - Consultant will be responsible for supplying a topographic survey performed by a Registered Land Surveyor with a minimum of 100' cross sections. Existing surface shall be in 1' contour intervals.
 - Obtain all field data, utility locations, mailboxes, driveways, storm pipes, etc., necessary
 to produce a survey suitable to civil design. Including telephone, cable, fire hydrants and
 water meters.
 - Provide the designs of the roads and round-a-bout identified that will allow for resurfacing and sidewalks of the roads with all necessary stormwater improvements, details, profiles and cross sections in accordance with Thomas County standards.
 - Completion of striping and signage plan. Striping plan shall include all tie-ins to existing paving. This plan can be done on the plan and profile sheets.

- Design of erosion and sedimentation BMPs with associated NPDES erosion and sedimentation control checklist must be provided.
- Provide quantity takeoffs for entire project.
- Provide technical specifications for products used in the design that are not identified on the plans or in the details.
- All aspects of this design will need to be approved and stamped by a Georgia Licensed Professional Engineer.
- Deliverables shall include 2 hard copies of plans and a digital set of plans in AutoCAD Civil 3d format (2021 or below). Also provide any applicable specifications, reports, takeoffs and E&S checklists.
- The scope of engineering services shall include the 7-Day BMP Inspection Letters performed by the ES&PC Plan design professional. Cost associated with this shall be included in the price for the project. Payment for this will be made at time of design but inspection will be scheduled at a later date.
- Owner will perform the bid process; however, the Consultant shall be available throughout the bid and construction process to address any issues or questions that may arise concerning the design.
- Additional services for unforeseen items and things not identified in this RFP, such as additional ROW acquisition survey, drainage easement acquisition, and legal descriptions. These services will be paid for hourly based on the Hourly Fee Scheduled submitted. This must also have approval by Thomas County Public Works Director prior to billing.
- Thomas County Public Works will perform daily jobsite inspections.

The scope of work completed by the Owner will generally include the following:

- Completion of "Front-End" contract documents required for bid. This does not include technical specifications or the unit price bid schedule.
- Procurement of additional property in support of design of roadway and/or stormwater management.
- Procurement of NPDES permits.
- Will assist in any necessary meetings with other agencies.
- Will include construction inspection and report any problems to consultant.
- Construction administration (pay request, close out documents, etc.)?

D. Project Experience

Provide a list of related project experience with pertinent project information. References should be provided for each project.

E. Project Scheduling

Please provide the number of calendar days, from the execution of the agreement of engineering services between the Owner and Consultant, to the completion and submittal of the plans for a 100% design review.

F. Project Team

Provide a 'Lump Sum' fee for the services included in this RFP in the submitted proposal. Price shall include charges for overhead, profit, taxes, printing, distribution, and other incidental items required to complete this project as described herein.

In addition to the "Lump Sum" price, please submit an Hourly Rate Schedule that will be utilized for changes in the scope of services approved by the Owner, for example periodic construction inspection and/or consultation not included in the RFP. This schedule shall include the hourly straight time base salary rates for all classifications in your organization and the effective period of the Hourly Rate Schedule.

H. Proposal Submittal/Additional Information

As Stated in "Item A" above, proposals will be evaluated based on experience, project team, schedule for completion, and lump sum price for engineering services. Proposals shall, at minimum, include all these items.


