### Bridges

Continued to pour concrete bridge slabs, certified by DOT.

Coolidge Rocky Ford Road – replace concrete box culvert with new bridge structure

### New Road Construction

Egg & Butter Road South between SR 202 and Fredonia Road – completed right of way acquisition and condemnation. Cleared County's r/w and Grady EMC's easement area for power line relocation. Installed cross drain pipe and poured concrete drain floor and headwalls.

### Other Work/Construction

Trash Collection Sites: Crews assist as needed to clean up around sites. Mow around sites and spray roundup for weed control. Hauled in dirt & base to fill in holes and spread to maintain unpaved sites.

Sunset Collection Site – Constructed guard house and began manning site in May, 2014.

Stewart Collection Site expansion – Widened site and extended fence and built another driveway for drive-thru and installed gate. Paved expansion.

SR 188 @ SR 202 Collection site – Constructed site for compactor and roll off wagons, built guard house, fenced and paved site. Began manning site in December, 2014.

2011 CDBG – Oak Hill Subdivision (Phase II of grant) – Completed construction of streets within subdivision.

Prison Garden – Assisted Warden by harrowing land, spreading lime and chemical spraying for inmate garden.

Judicial Center – Constructed new parking lot.

Sunset Ag Center – Set up for and cleaned up after livestock shows

Firing Range – Built forms for sidewalk and target slab and poured. Built up berm and cut down vegetation overgrowth. Shooting club paid for rock and asphalt millings and county forces spread materials.

Keep Thomas County Beautiful – provided 4 drivers and transit buses for county wide litter survey.

Hancock Center on Smith Avenue – Repair failures in parking lot, cut down several trees, reset manhole. Installed barricades until work can be completed.

Jail Justice Center parking lot expansion – Assisted contractor by digging up construction area and hauling off dirt and debris. Cut down trees and shot grade for new construction area.

Thomas County Library – Assisted Building Maintenance Department by digging up area where water line was leaking. Hauled in base and leveled out cut. Patched with asphalt.

Safety Action Plan – This state funded plan provided new safety signage, striping, and reflectors on Palmer, Summerhill, Five Forks, Ozell, Patten Coolidge, Stewart, Hall, and Springhill Roads (67.38 miles) \$162,338.25

#### Municipality Work:

City of Barwick: Utilized charge crew 12 days this year. Assisted City in digging up leaking waterline.

Employee hours – 106

Inmate hours – 557

City of Boston: Utilized charge crew 46.75 days this year. Routinely bladed/ditched Oak Street. Loaned barricades and cones to the City of events. Prepared Oak Street by ditching and grading for #57 limerock installation. City purchased materials and County forces spread and rolled rock on street. This job charged against 2014 in kind labor/equipment services allotment. Emergency call in request for tree across Leak Street.

Employee Hours – 490.25

Inmate Hours – 2,581

City of Coolidge: Filled in abandoned City well behind old City Hall Office. Repaired storm drain on Marshall Trace. Coolidge paid for all materials involved in these two jobs. Labor/equipment charged against 2014 kind allotment. Bladed Walnut Street.  
Employee Hours – 13.50  
Inmate Hours – 22

City of Meigs: Utilized charge crew 46 days this year. Loaned City large steel plate to cover hole in road from waterline repair. Installed driveway on Boyd Street – City billed for installation. Mowed with boom mower on Carter Street. Emergency call in request for tree across Collins Street. Routinely bladed/ditched dirt streets. Emergency call in request from city to cut tree off roadway, Loaned barricades and cones to the City for various road closures.  
Employee Hours – 428.75  
Inmate Hours – 2,241

City of Ochlocknee: Assisted City with repair of waterlines in two spots on SR 188, city billed for all charges incurred. Worked emergency call from City to remove trees off roadway on several streets. Crews cleaned up and hauled off debris from tree, charges of labor/equipment charged against 2014 in kind services allotment. Hauled in two loads of sand and spread at Old South Day event grounds. Provided roll off containers and serviced for Old South Day, hand crew cleaned up after event.  
Employee Hours – 53.50  
Inmate Hours – 76.50

City of Pavo: Utilized charge crew 11 days this year. Replaced 3 cross drain pipes and resurfaced over cuts, Pavo paid for all materials from Public Works stock – City provided a lot of the materials themselves. Leveled out City's inert debris pit. Charges of labor/equipment charged against 2014 in kind services allotment. Loaned barricades and cones to the City for road closures for Peacock Day.  
Employee Hours – 344.50  
Inmate Hours – 817.25

City of Thomasville: Built retaining wall at the Landfill for the City's new convenience center. City furnished majority of materials – City reimbursed County for County stock materials used.
