Metcalfe Road – Contracted with Blount Construction for a full depth reclamation on entire road between the Florida Line and US 319 south, 10.27 miles (not thru Metcalfe City limits) an with Scruggs Company for resurfacing. Total cost of project - \$3,298,232. Utilized 2014 and 2015 LMIG (Local Maintenance Improvement Grant) - \$1,066,720.12 given to Thomas County by the State toward this widening and resurfacing project.

Bridges

Ethel Crosby Lane - Replaced timber bridge that caved in with 64' – 42" concrete pipe and rip rap headwalls.

New Road Construction

Egg & Butter Road South between SR 202 and Fredonia Road – completed building road and paved. Project completed December 2015.

Red Hills Business Park – Built the road system throughout the entire business park. Will be complete by sometime in March 2016.

Other Work/Construction

Trash Collection Sites: Crews assist as needed to clean up around sites. Mow around sites and spray roundup for weed control. Hauled in dirt & base to fill in holes and spread to maintain unpaved sites.

Hansell Collection Site - Built compactor walls and floor, put down base and asphalt. Building Maintenance began guard house construction in December 2015.

2014 CDBG – Lillie Lane off SR 202 and Brinson Road and Thomas Drive off Dillon Road – Cut back r/w and began getting pipe and materials ordered in preparation for construction.

Prison Garden – Assisted Warden by harrowing land, spreading lime and chemical spraying for inmate garden.

Sunset Ag Center – Set up for and cleaned up after livestock shows

Keep Thomas County Beautiful – provided 4 drivers and transit buses for county wide litter survey.

Hancock Center on Smith Avenue – Removed curbs and trees, filled in areas with base and resurfaced over those areas.

Jail Justice Center building and parking lot expansion – In an effort to cut costs on new addition, Thomas County assisted the contractors in building the parking lots and demolition of the old parking lot, which was done in phases. Assisted contractor in demolition of walls and clearing trees.

City of Barwick: Utilized charge crew 11.75 days this year.

Resurfaced Mamie Street and backed up shoulders to new resurfacing.

City of Meigs: Utilized charge crew 41.75 days this year. Routinely bladed dirt streets. Patched potholes on streets city wide. Spread rock, sand, and asphalt millings on several dirt streets for City.

City of Ochlocknee: Utilized charge crew 14.25 days this year. Hauled in sand and spread at Old South Day event grounds. Provided roll off containers and serviced for Old South Day, hand crew cleaned up after event. Provided roll off container for Christmas parade. Provided roll off containers for two week period for a city wide cleanup project. Picked up storm debris door-to-door for two different storm events and chipped debris. Emergency tree call in on Beverly Street. Closed Pine Street at bridge and made temporary emergency repair. Routinely bladed Fielding and Hager Streets. Tore down old lean shelter behind library. Chipped cut tree from charge crew. Patched potholes on streets city wide.
