The Thomas County Board of Commissioners met on the above date in a regular scheduled meeting at 6:00 p.m. at the Historic Courthouse, Commission Chambers, with the following board members present:

Chairman Grady told the board Commissioner Baggett and County Manager Stephenson were in Atlanta for training. The board expressed condolences for Commissioner Rich for the loss of his mother. Commission Vonier is still recovering from surgery.

Chairman Grady recognized Commissioner Hickey who made a motion to approve the minutes of the 2/12/2019 board meeting. The motion was seconded by Vice-Chairman Brown. Motion carried unanimously; Chairman Grady, Vice-Chairman Brown, Gross, Hickey, and NeSmith voting aye.




