The Thomas County Board of Commissioners met on the above date in a regular scheduled meeting at 6:00 p.m. at the Historic Courthouse, Commission Chambers, with the following board members present:

Staff present was County Manager Michael J. Stephenson, Bruce County Attorney Warren, and County Clerk Twink Monahan. Media present was Patti Dozier, Times Enterprise. Other staff present was Fleet Service Director Jamie Parrott

Chairman Grady recognized Commissioner Hickey who made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 12, 2019 board meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Baggett. Motion carried unanimously; Chairman Grady, Vice-Chairman Brown, Commissioners Gross, Hickey, NeSmith, and Baggett aye.

Jamie Parrott, Thomas County's representative on the Southwest GA Regional Board for MH/MR/SA MH, asked the board to participate in an on-line survey for the regional board.


Mr. Stephenson reported a City of Thomasville Sanitation truck drove over a water meter at the Ochlocknee Fire Station and broke a 2" water main. The Town of Ochlocknee has only one cut-off valve so all of Ochlocknee was without water Monday afternoon. County crews from Facilities Management were assisting City crews in reestablishing water service to the community.

Chairman Grady recognized Commissioner NeSmith who made a motion to ratify the purchase of a new 2019 Peterbilt 328 truck from Precision Peterbilt with a 50,000 #Ampiroll Hooklift hoist from Transport Equipment for \$169,724 and the discontinue of the Commercial Collections on June 30, 2019. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hickey. Motion carried unanimously; Chairman Grady, Vice-Chairman Brown, Commissioners, Gross, Hickey, NeSmith, and Baggett voting aye.

Chairman Grady recognized Commissioner NeSmith who made a motion to ratify the diesel purchase on 3/25/2019 from Petroleum Products at \$2.0505. The motion was seconded by Vice-Chairman Brown. Motion carried unanimously; Chairman Grady, Vice-Chairman Brown, Commissioners, Gross, Hickey, NeSmith, and Baggett voting aye.

Chairman Grady recognized Vice-Chairman Phillip Brown who made a motion to approve Budget Amendment 19-3-1 SPLOST 2017 CPF Fund 329 and SPLOST 2012 CPF Fund 328. The motion was seconded by Commissioner NeSmith. Motion carried unanimously; Chairman Grady, Vice-Chairman Brown, Commissioners, Gross, Hickey, NeSmith, and Baggett voting aye.

Chairman Grady recognized Vice-Chairman Brown who made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Baggett. Motion carried unanimously; Chairman Grady, Vice-Chairman Brown, Commissioners Gross, Hickey, NeSmith, and Baggett aye.
