The Thomas County Board of Commissioners met on the above date in a regular scheduled meeting at 9:00 a.m. at the Historic Courthouse, Commission Chambers, with the following board members present:

Commissioner Rich gave the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Chairman Grady recognized Commissioner Baggett who made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 28, 2019 Board Meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hickey. Motion carried unanimously; Chairman Grady, Commissioners Rich, Hickey, Gross, NeSmith, and Baggett voting aye.

Chairman Grady recognized Commissioner Hickey who made a motion to approve the recommendations of the Purchasing Committee from June 4 and award the following bids:

1. Aggregate rock from Conrad Yelvington Dist., 180-day contract at bid prices and order as needed.
2. Concrete pipe from Foley Product, 180-day contract at bid prices and order as needed.
3. Redi-Mix cement from Scruggs Concrete Co., annual contract and order as needed.
4. Turnout gear for the Fire Department from Municipal Equipment, total \$49,158.00

The motion was seconded by Commissioner NeSmith and approved unanimously: Chairman Grady, Commissioners Rich, Hickey, Gross, NeSmith and Baggett voting aye.

Commissioner Rich asked for a committee be formed to plan for the Bi-Centennial anniversary of Thomas County in 2025. Chairman Grady said Commissioner Rich could chair the committee.

Chairman Grady recognized Vice Chairman Brown who made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Baggett. Motion carried unanimously; ayes Chairman Grady, Commissioners Rich, Hickey, Gross, NeSmith, and Baggett voting aye.
