Minutes Historic Courthouse, Board Chambers, 3rd Floor 225 North Board Street

February 25, 2020

The Thomas County Board of Commissioners met on the above date in a regular scheduled meeting at 6:00 p.m. at the Historic Courthouse, Commission Chambers, with the following board members present:

Staff present was County Manager Michael J. Stephenson, County Attorney Bruce Warren, Planning Director Ken Gay, and County Clerk Celeste Tyler.

Chairman Brown called the meeting to order, and Commissioner Rich gave the invocation.

Chairman Brown recognized Commissioner Baggett who made a motion to approve the minutes of the February 11, 2020 Board Meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Vonier. The motion was approved unanimously with Chairman Brown and Commissioners Baggett, Grady, Gross, Hickey, NeSmith, Rich, and Vonier voting aye.

Chairman Brown declared a Public Hearing in regards to Application 20-2-1, applicant Thomas County Board of Commissioners.

Chairman Brown recognized County Manager Stephenson who reviewed the application and text changes for the Land Use Standards Ordinance and the Zoning Policies, Procedures and Standards. He also highlighted section 4.230 Standards of Review #10 of the current ordinance. He stated that the recommendation of eliminating this section would remove any ambiguity the staff would have in determining an adverse effect to property values.

Chairman Brown recognized Commissioner NeSmith who addressed Planning Director Ken Gay on the "reasonable time" verbiage that is listed in Section 4.260 Action by Board of Commissioners #2. Commissioner NeSmith wanted confirmation that at the conclusion of a Public Hearing, the Board of Commissioners could make a decision or have the option to defer a decision to a future meeting. County Attorney Warren agreed that both options exist.

Chairman Brown recognized Commissioner Grady who made a motion to approve application 20-2-1 that would amend the Thomas County Land Use Standards Ordinance Section 4.000 Administrative Standards and the Thomas County Zoning Policies, Procedures, and Standards. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Baggett. The motion passed 7-1 with Chairman

Brown and Commissioners Baggett, Grady, Hickey, NeSmith, Rich and Vonier voting aye. Commissioner Gross voted nay.

In the Open Meeting to Citizens Chairman Brown recognized Mayubrhai Patel of 801 E. Water Street, Bainbridge, Georgia 39817. Mr. Patel is the convenience store owner of Pantry #1 located at 9083 GA Hwy 33, Pavo, Georgia 31778 and is requesting a Beer and Wine License at said location.

Chairman Brown recognized Commissioner Baggett who made a motion to approve the application for a Beer and Wine License as requested by Mayubrhai Patel for Pantry #1 located at 9083 GA Hwy 33 Pave, Georgia 31778. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hickey. The motion was approved unanimously with Chairman Brown and Commissioners Baggett, Grady, Gross, Hickey, NeSmith, Rich, and Vonier voting aye.

Chairman Brown recognized Roger Walker of 15770 N US Hwy 319, Thomasville, Georgia who congratulated Laura Nichols on her promotion and the good work she does for Thomas County. He also encouraged the Board of Commissioners to continue Capital Improvement planning and expressed concern over the closing of the Merriville polling location.

Chairman Brown recognized Commissioner Rich who made a motion to ratify the 2019 End of Year Budget Amendment 20-2-1, as presented below. Commissioner Baggett seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously with Chairman Brown and Commissioners Baggett, Grady, Gross, Hickey, NeSmith, Rich, and Vonier voting aye.
