Chairman NeSmith called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. Pastor Clay Phillips of Rose City Church of Christ gave the invocation.

Chairman NeSmith recognized Commissioner Vonier, who made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 8, 2025, meeting. Commissioner Baggett seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously with Chairman NeSmith, Commissioners Baggett, Brown, Hickey, Grady, Vonier, Gross, and Rich voting aye.

Chairman NeSmith recognized Commissioner Brown, who made a motion to approve the agenda for the July 22, 2025, meeting; Commissioner Baggett seconded. The motion passed unanimously with all Commissioners voting aye.

Commissioner Hickey announced the Public Works Meeting on July 23, 2025, at 8:30 a.m.
