- Approved preliminary plat for Red Tip Acres on Hwy 122
- Approved Budget Amendment 21-11-1 / American Rescue Plan Act 2021 Funds
- Approved a package beer and wine license request for Sandhya N. Patel, Neelkanth, LLC dba Quick Express at 21967 US Hwy 19 North, Thomasville, GA
- Declared scrap from the Old Shop, a chain-link fence, and Unit #20 1982 International Roll back truck as surplus and authorized items to be sold on GovDeals online auction
- Open Meeting to the Citizens: recognized Candee Henderson of 1453 Egg and Butter Rd. South, Thomasville, GA who requested consideration for a joint resolution between the City of Thomasville and Thomas County that would commit to the goal of 100% renewable energy by 2035; recognized Lucinda Brown of 103 Halcyon Way, Thomasville, GA who inquired about the rescheduling of two Community Meetings regarding ARPA funds that were postponed due to an uptick in COVID-19 numbers in September
- Ratified purchase of diesel fuel from Petroleum Products for \$2.6147/gal on 11/2/2021
- Ratified acceptance of \$30,011.33 as vehicle settlement on wrecked Ford Interceptor
