The Thomas County Board of Commissioners met on the above date in a public hearing 6:00 p.m. at the Historic Courthouse, Commission Chambers, with the following board members present:

Commissioner NeSmith made a motion to appoint County Manager Michael J. Stephenson to the Georgia Pines Service Board; two-year term beginning 1/1/2019 and ending 12/31/2020. The motion was seconded by Vice-Chairman Brown. Motion carried unanimously; Chairman Grady, Vice-Chairman Brown, Commissioners Baker, Gross, NeSmith, and Ansley voting aye. Commissioners Kenneth Hickey and Zippy Vonier were absent.


