- Open Meeting to the Citizens: recognized Candee Henderson of 1453 Egg and Butter Rd., Thomasville, Georgia who continued to encourage the Board to commit to the goal of 100% renewable energy by 2035. A resolution was distributed for consideration. Chairman NeSmith recognized Jeanette Dixon of 148 Cindy Drive, Thomasville, Georgia who requested the Board to update the County's Animal Control Ordinances.
- Denied request made by David and Linda Poss to put a mobile home on Wilora's Lane that would contradict the County's ordinance that does not allow a variance for a private lane/drive
- Appointed Alfred Carver of 1806 Parramore Rd, Coolidge, Georgia to the Thomas County Public Library Board
- Approved the funds as outlined in the Thomas County Accountability Court grant
- Adopted a Resolution for the Capital Improvements Element Annual Update
- Declared concrete pipe from Egg & Butter Rd., Newton Rd., and Airline Rd. as surplus and authorized the sale of the pipe on GovDeals online auction
- Announced that the bridge on Whitney Camp Road is out and the road closure is expected to last for approximately 2 weeks
- Reviewed RFP (Request for Proposal) for a new CAD System
- Ratified authorization to negotiate contract with Falcon Design Consultants for Jordan Oaks Subdivision
- Announced a Purchasing Committee meeting on July 5, 2022
