- 2. All goods and materials will be F.O.B. Thomas County Board of Commissioners Job Site, 270 Joiner Road, Thomasville, Ga, 31757, in Thomas County and no freight or postage charges will be paid by Thomas County unless such charges are included in the bid price.
- 3. All bids must be sealed, received and in-hand at bid due date and time. Each bidder assumes the responsibility for having his/her bid received at the designated time and place without consideration, regardless of the postmark. Thomas County accepts no responsibility for mail delivery.
- 4. Each bid form submitted must include the name of the business, mailing address, the name, title and signature of the person submitting the bid. When submitting a bid package to Thomas County, the first page of your bid package should be the Bid Form listing price, delivery, etc. unless the bid form is requested to be in a separate sealed envelope.
- 5. No bids received after said time or at any place other than the time and place stated in the notice will be considered.
- 6. Thomas County may reject any and all bids, and must reject a bid of any party who has been delinquent or unfaithful in any formal contract with Thomas County. Scope of Work:

- 1.) Install 423 ft. of 6 ft. 9-gauge chain link fence with 20 weight top rails, 20 weight line posts, and schedule 40 corner posts backfilled with concrete.
- 2.) Install 164 ft. of 6 ft 9-gauge chain link fence with 20 weight top rails, 20 weight line posts, and schedule 40 corner posts on **asphalt surface** backfilled with concrete.
- 3.) Install 281 ft. of 7ft 9-gauge chain link fence buried 1 ft. in the ground with 20 weight top rails, 20 weight line posts, and schedule 40 corner posts backfilled with concrete.
- 4.) Install 96' of 7 ft. 9-gauge chain link fence with privacy slats, 20 weight top rails, 20 weight line posts, and schedule 40 corner posts backfilled with concrete.
- 5.) Install 28' Manual double swing 9-gauge chain link gate with duckbills.
- 6.) Install 24 ft. automatic chain link sliding gate 110v backfilled with concrete. (Slide master CSL) power supplied by others
- 7.) Install nine 10 ft. chain link single swing manual gates with duck bills backfilled with concrete.
- 8.) Install eight 3 ft. chain link Single Swing manual gates with duck bills backfilled with concrete.
- 9.) Kennel Perimeter will be poured concrete 4" wide x 12" depth this includes fence and gates.
