



**PERMANENT HOMES FOR CHILDREN

The Permanent home for Children in Georgia Program is a Program of the Georgia Council of Juvenile Court Judges. The program was established to help children who are currently placed in foster care find permanent homes. It is a goal of the program to reunite as many of these children, as possible, with their own families. The Thomas County Juvenile Court is currently recruiting new volunteers for the Program. Volunteers form Citizen Review Panels that meet monthly to insure that children who are placed in foster care do not drift in the system for long periods of time. Panel members frequently develop and secure resources to help improve the quality of life for children and their families. They also help their local community have a better understanding and support the work of the Juvenile Court and the local Department of Family and Children Services.
